

medical and surgical specialty that focuses on head and neck diseases and disorders.




#### Ophthalmology

#### Orthopaedic Surgery


Treatment of disorders of the bones, joints, ligaments, tendons and muscles.

## DIAGNOSTIC TESTS


In Alberta you'll be waiting 7 weeks to recieve a CT-Scan compared to Saskatchewan where you'll only be waiting 2.5 weeks.
